AFFIRMED SUCCESS broke alertly, raced close up while in hand, was angled to the inside on the backstretch, advanced inside on the turn, split rivals approaching the stretch, drew clear when roused and remained safely clear under a drive. VOODOO was bumped after the start, dropped back early, rallied four wide nearing the stretch and finished gamely outside. BURNING ROMA was outrun early, raced inside on the turn, altered course in upper stretch, was in tight quarters in midstretch then finished gamely. SAY FLORIDA SANDY chased the pace along the inside and drifted out while tiring in the stretch. DREAM RUN ducked out at the start, was bumped, was hustled along inside and lacked a solid finishing kick. RUSTY SPUR was bumped at the start but quickly showed in front, set the pace and tired in the final furlong. HERE'S ZEALOUS chased the pace while three wide, drifted out on the turn and drifted while tiring in the stretch. PEEPING TOM was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and had no rally. SNOW RIDGE chased the pace from the outside and was taken up while tiring when in tight quarters in midstretch. SHIBBOLETH stumbled badly at the start, raced inside and tired.
