SAY FLORIDA SANDY was unhurried outside early on, rallied four wide on the turn, drew clear when roused and was kept to a drive to the wire. DELAWARE TOWNSHIP raced close up inside, was sent up into traffic entering the stretch, bumping soundly with SHADOW CASTER, was taken up then finished gamely but could not get to the winner. LAKE PONTCHARTRAIN was outrun early as stable mate PRINCE MONTY argued the pace, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. KASHATREYA was outrun early, put in a good run along the inside into the stretch and lacked a solid finishing kick. MAX'S PAL contested the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. SHADOW CASTER raced close up outside, rallied three wide nearing the stretch, was bumped soundly as DELAWARE TOWNSHIP attempted to bull his way through turning for home and tired. PRINCE MONTY contested the pace from the outside and tired in the stretch.
