HISTORY STARTS NOW sat reserved towards the two path, nestled between rivals for nearly a half, followed STYLISH FELLA advancing in the right direction nearing the quarter pole, tipped to the outside of the previously mentioned foe after settling into upper stretch, commenced to rally when given his cue, gained readily on the leader, took over a short distance from the eighth pole and edged away under a vigorous hand ride. STYLISH FELLA put to a good hold early, contently pressed the pacesetter from the two path, moved when ready with a quick bid nearing the quarter pole, turned for home with a clear advantage, was let out after entering the stretch, felt the top one's presence soon afterwards, gave in to that opponent, but went on to easily secure the place. SLEWLANTIC put to some hand urging leaving the gate, was taken hold of, settling into the pocket after being out sprinted, tracked the front runners, well within range, well placed and still well in hand, was asked for a response turning for home, but failed to muster up the needed kick. BILL SENIOR broke outward a bit, was grabbed hold, put back on a straight course and sent on to assume early command, darted over to the inside just past the half mile pole, offered little resistance when confronted by the runner up leaving the five-sixteenths pole, yielded readily and steadily tired thereafter. CAPTAIN FERTOLI raced three wide and folded. ASHLEY'S MISSION four wide, trailed throughout.
