Footnotes

MY REDBYRD settled at the rear of the field upon reaching the homestretch, saved ground for most of the run around the opening bend before spinning from the two path into the backstretch, continued to bide time under a good hold from the rider proceeding towards the three-eighths pole, was gradually taken outward, until placed four wide by the five-sixteenths pole, was put to encouragement and turned for home, rapidly cut into the leader's margin, poked a head in front in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole then kicked clear, crossing the wire, hand urged. SHARNBERRY (GB) showed the way, rated near the inside, came under heavy pressure late on the far turn and was soon let out in response to it, held her ground well from upper to midstretch, gave in to the winner's challenge with about a sixteenth to go, then out gamed CHECK POINT to secure second.. CHECK POINT contently rode the pocket, was kept on hold waiting behind the leader approaching the quarter pole, attempted to close in with a rail rally, flattened out. ARCH SUPPORT pressed the issue from the outside in the early stages, was successfully eased back out of the role of stalker leaving the first turn, sat within range from off the inside until the quarter pole, got set down entering the stretch and got out finished. ROMIN ROBIN forwardly placed three wide until the three-eighths pole, weakened in the final furlong. LITTLE OFTEN ANNI out broke the field and made her way down the elbow chute as an apparent reluctant early leader, was put to a strong grip on the reins and taken back just before reaching the homestretch, got put to even more pronounced stout restraint just before reaching the first turn, spun three wide into the backstretch and remained well off the inside thereafter, stayed within striking distance for just over six furlongs, got asked for a response turning for home, came up empty.
