Footnotes

MUTINY patiently stalked the pacesetter, parked out in the two path, moved when ready and went by without need of urging to take over coming to the

quarter pole, turned for home and only then got asked for run, lengthened away during the ensuing furlong, fended off the runner up, driving. POWER KING reserved within striking distance from the two path under a good hold for nearly three-quarters, drifted out noticeably leaving the furlong grounds, yet remained well clear of the others for the place. SUMMER SHARE chased from outside, lacked the necessary stretch response. EMINENT TALE checked along the rail when put in a bit tight by CINDER CONE midway down the backstretch, was taken off the rail in time for the run around the bend, angled to be five wide at the three-sixteenths pole, got straightened away and mustered up a mild kick to grab the final major slice of the pot. WILDLEE SPECIAL three wide departing the backstretch, had no rally. SASTRE saved ground and tired. CON THE CAT in the four path at the half mile pole, was under a drive a furlong later, came up empty. FRENCH TRANSITION came five wide into the lane, and went on to improve position. CINDER CONE was no factor. GET READY GO sluggish at the start, was outrun. LAUNCH N RELAUNCH took the overland route on the turn and folded. DAKOTA ROADHOUSE showed the way from the inside, offered little resistance when confronted by the winner nearing the quarter pole, yielding readily, then retreated. LINCOLN PENNY six wide at the head of the lane, offered little.
