### Footnotes

VERBOSITY initially four wide in close pursuit, shifted to the two path heading into the turn, took over the front just past the three-eighths pole while well rated, was set down at the quarter pole, dug in through the final furlong under a drive to inch away and prevail. MODERN CHILD unhurried two to three wide in the turn, came under coaxing to pick up the pace at the five-sixteenths, swung five wide in upper stretch, rallied down the center of the course displaying a good kick through the lane to just garner the place with a late surge. HALF NELSON vied inside throughout, came under light coaxing at the five-sixteenths, fought on when roused through the lane unable to reel in the top one while being displaced in the last jump and settled for show. WISHINGONASTAR saved ground throughout, steadily improved position in the turn while under hand urging along the rail from the three-eighths, angled out nearing the final furlong for a clear lane, drifted and bumped JETER in midstretch and was corrected and taken off in the midst of displaying good energy through the latter portions of the drive. JETER reserved in midpack, raced four wide throughout, was bumped in midstretch by WISHINGONASTAR, and was outfinished for a major share in the late stages. LITTLE DALE showed brief speed vying between rivals into the turn, steadily retreated thereafter. ZONE BREAKER forwardly placed chasing the front three wide, came under a prolonged drive from the three-eighths to keep pace, couldn't, and tired. MIGHTY ONE settled towards the rear, raced four to five wide throughout and offered little. FIRST VERSE brushed the left side leaving the gate at the start, was outrun early on while placed three wide and never threatened.
