SUNNY DESERT four wide within aim of the leaders, came under encouragement at the three-eighths pole, angled five wide in upper stretch, rallied into prominence a furlong out, took command at the sixteenth marker displaying a good kick to prevail. ERIN ENCHANTED tracked the pace along the inside within range, angled out placed to a ride four wide in upper stretch, rallied taking command a furlong out, got headed a sixteenth later while running on willingly clear of the rest for the place honors. HARBOR MIST away alertly to establish the pace just off the inside, dueled from the half mile pole with FREUD'S NOTEBOOK to her inside through the turn, got asked at the five-sixteenths, fought on to the eighth pole when displaced then weakened in the final furlong. VICKI'S DANCER three wide in close proximity of the lead, took closer order urged nearing the quarter pole, swung three wide offering up a mild bid in upper stretch before weakening in the late stages. FREUD'S NOTEBOOK prompted the pace early on inside, ranged up to seize a narrow advantage at the half mile pole, dueled with HARBOR MIST through the turn coming under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, waited with briefly before cutting the corner into the stretch as the lane grew a bit tight momentarily then tired in the drive.
