### Footnotes

POOVEY pressed the pace from outside for six furlongs, opened a clear advantage in upper stretch then held well under urging in the late stages. EIGHTYFIVE S raced in hand along the rail just behind the leaders for five furlongs, angled three wide entering the stretch, made a run to threaten in midstretch and was fully extended to hold for the place. MADAM COMMANDER was outrun for a half after breaking slowly, moved out on the far turn, split rivals four wide at the to of the stretch and rallied belatedly. CHARMING MANDATE raced in midpack while three wide and finished evenly. STUDY ABROAD raced between rivals, was in traffic on the far turn and lacked a late response. SHANNON H moved out early, raced just off the pace for a half, drifted five wide at the quarter pole and lacked a further response. BOKEN LADY hustled up, set the pace on the rail for six furlongs and gave way. BEEQUEONE failed to mount a serious rally while saving ground throughout. ROYAL SKIP checked slightly at the start and was never close thereafter.
