RIPPLES N' WAVES away well, sparred briefly with NOT NOW ASHLEY, before being eased back to take up the role of stalker, patiently kept a watchful eye on the aforementioned rival, parked just off that one's hind quarters, advanced to re bid for the lead, when ready, coming to the quarter pole, won the duel through the furlong grounds, heading to the eighth pole with a clear advantage, then lengthened away the last eighth, ridden out. MAGNIFICENT MOON tracked the front runners while taking the inside route, angled out for the stretch drive and kicked in with good energy to out finish NOT NOW ASHLEY for place honors. NOT NOW ASHLEY settled along the rail soon after the start, went head to head with the winner briefly before edging away to a clear lead midway down the backstretch, came under pressure from the top one once again approaching the quarter pole, succumbed readily a short distance into the stretch drive and steadily tired thereafter. POINT OF ENTRY three wide, was urged on the turn but failed to reach a contending position. BOMBER BOY saved ground until the quarter pole. CORUNDUM tucked into the two path at the half mile pole and folded.
