Footnotes

HAVE YOU EVER shot out of the gate to establish command, maneuvered over to the inside in plenty of time for the run around the bend, cut the pace, under a good hold, and under pursuit from FASTUS CACTUS, turned back an abbreviated challenge from the previously mentioned opponent entering the stretch and held sway, being flashed the whip intermittently right handed to mind his manners to the wire. FASTUS CACTUS away in good order, took up chase on the winner, was kept entrenched towards the two path, within range around the bend, under good handling, advanced to issue a challenge for the front leaving the five-sixteenths pole, wasn't up to the task, being easily repulsed, but continued on with good energy to hold on to the place. I AIN'T NO SAINT chased the leader from the outside, was asked for some run at the five-sixteenths, headed into lane two wide under much stronger encouragement but proved no match for the top twosome. CALLIDE VALLEY underwent a three wide pursuit but made no serious bids. MAKE NOTE saved ground until the quarter pole and improved position. CANTRUSHPERFECTION raced along the outside and had no stretch offering. MIDDLE BANK saved ground throughout.
