GLORY IN MOTION pressed the pace from outside the entire way, dueled heads apart through the stretch and got up in the final strides. BOBITY BOO set the pace along the rail while being pressed by the winner into deep stretch and yielded grudgingly. REFINERY FIRE settled in good position for five furlongs, rallied three wide at the quarter pole and finished willingly. LOYAL SHADOW raced in midpack, advanced four wide on the turn and rallied mildly. NURSE DOLCE steadied along the inside leaving the first turn, raced well back to the turn then closed late from outside. ES MIA was reserved for a half, gained in traffic between horses, moved up on the turn and flattened out. UP UP AWAY raced up close along the rail to the top of the stretch and gave way. ILLGIVEYOUWATTEVER steadied leaving the gate and on the first turn and was never close thereafter.
