QUIET SUNSHINE underwent a three wide pursuit, had already been put to encouragement prior to the quarter pole, drove past the runner up in the final seventy yards to prove best. TALENT N PASSION initially hustled to the front, got switched over to being rated after having secured it, dashed over to the inside and showed the way from there on an open lead, got called upon after the half had been completed, offered some resistance before relinquishing past the sixteenth pole. FIRST PENNY stalked without making her presence felt from the two path, got outfinished by the top twosome. GUYANA PRINCESS got away a beat slowly, arrived at the half mile pole taking the inside route and having been put to a drive, spun four wide into upper stretch, mustered up a mild response to grab the last major award. INAFLASH angled off the rail approaching the quarter pole, made no headway. PEGASUS DIAMOND gave chase from the two path, left the five-sixteenths pole being encouraged, was taken in hand in close proximity of INAFLASH as that opponent was being maneuver towards the outside with about a furlong remaining, made no impact.
