APRIL'S BENEFIT broke awkwardly, was steadied after the start, was rated along inside, rallied on the second turn, angled out in midstretch and was along in time from the outside. HOLY BOLLA quickly showed in front, set the pace along the inside, took a clear lead past the eighth pole and dug in gamely but could not withstand the winner. RULINA, close up inside, put in a run along the rail on the second turn but was unable to sustain that bid. PERSONAL PRINCESS, outrun early, raced inside and was no real threat with a mild late rally. MINING CALSKEY chased the pace while between rivals and tired in the stretch. MAID OF SILVER chased the pace while three wide and tired. BANGKOK BABY, rated along outside, raced wide and tired.
