Footnotes

ADCAT, rated along on the rail, advanced inside on the second turn, came wide into the stretch, dug in gamely and prevailed under a steady drive. WHITE BLAZE, taken back after the start, came wide for the drive and finished full of run. SENOR CHOP CHOP, never far back, rallied on the second turn and stayed on determinedly to the finish. MAGNIFICENT BOY quickly sprinted clear, set the pace while well in hand then struggled in the stretch. SURUMU'S ACCOUNT, never far back, put in a run along the inside on the second turn but had little left for the stretch drive. COMPLY WITH DI raced inside and had no rally. MARCUS IBIS chased the pace and tired after three quarters. BAL HARBOUR tired badly.
