Footnotes

WHEELS UP saved ground along the backstretch, moved between horses on the turn, split rivals entering the stretch then drew clear in the late stages. SOUPER BUTTERFLY was outrun for six furlongs, circled five wide at the quarter pole and closed strongly in the middle of the track. CITY VICAR raced in midpack, made a strong three wide move on the turn, battled inside the winner into deep stretch and yielded late. DONNA'S SANDEE saved ground for a half, split horses on the turn then rallied mildly along the fence. SMALL POTATOES raced in midpack, gained four wide midway on the turn and flattened out. LA GIOIA DITUTTI set or forced the pace along the rail and gave way on the turn. SHE'S GOT THUNDER was never a factor while racing wide. OUR MONTANA DREAM pressed the pace between horses into upper stretch and gave way. DANCE FOR FASHION rushed up three wide to take the lead before going a half, led to the quarter pole and faltered. WISE PITCH steadied with the rider losing the irons on the first turn, moved out, made a middle move four wide, gave way.
