MARIAH SCARY raced uncontested on the rail into upper stretch and drew away under good handling. BUDDYS DREAM was taken in hand at the start, raced well back, swung four wide and closed late to gain the place. GREENS N BEANS chased outside, lodged a three wide bid on the turn and weakened in midstretch. CLASSY JET chased the winner on the rail and tired late. CASING GOLD steadied briefly at the five-eighths pole, swung three wide and lacked a late response. JUSTGIVEMEASECOND raced in hand along the rail, swung wide and failed to menace. PINK GOOSE raced in traffic leaving the backstretch, angled in on the turn and lacked a rally. BEST DECISION was used up trying to keep the early pace. OMMADON'S THUNDER was in hand at the start and trailed throughout.
