### Footnotes

TAR HEEL MOM was hustled up between horses, angled to the rail after opening a clear early advantage, set the pace to the turn, repulsed a minor threat in upper stretch and edged away under steady right hand encouragement. HOUR GLASS raced in hand while saving ground, rallied along the rail on the far turn, angled outside the winner while making a move at the quarter pole but couldn't gain on that one through the stretch while clearly best of the others. MATCHLESS ORINDA was well placed on the backstretch, lodged a three wide move midway on the turn and flattened out in midstretch. JUSTWHISTLEDIXIE dropped back soon after the start, was outrun while saving ground for five furlongs and lacked a strong closing response. THUNDERS DOVE pressed briefly on the rail, checked a bit and moved out at the five-eighths pole, chased the winner for a half and gave way on the turn then steadily tired thereafter.
