HOLLYWOOD SCRIPT travelled three wide on each bend, loosely drafting behind the runner up, was put to some urging and picked interest upon departing the backstretch, tipped slightly wider heading into the stretch, altered course inward soon afterwards, split foes while challenging for command at the eighth pole, took over shortly afterwards and kicked clear. AMBER COAST a forward factor three wide, challenged in earnest as the field headed for the top of the lane, was between rivals in pursuit of gaining command when the winner arrived on the scene, got outfinished by that foe the rest of the way but was kept going well enough to turn back a fast-closing pair to preserve the place. HARDROCKER bided time while racing inside until the end of the backstretch, got eased into the two path at the three-eighths pole, entered the stretch and was let loose, picked up a partner in SKY LOVER by midstretch while rallying, altered course to the outside in the vicinity of the sixteenth pole and displayed a good finish down the center of the course to take the show and narrowly missing taking the second spot as well. SKY LOVER swung three wide into the stretch and came home with good late energy. RICOCHET COURT rated near the two path until the quarter pole, was confronted by the runner up at that station, with a couple of others cranking up the pressure as well slightly behind, held out to the eighth pole before yielding and backing away. CASHLEIGH four wide at the head of the stretch, mustered up a mild response to mainly improve position. D'ORO DANCER tracked the front runners from the pocket on the far turn, came up empty when called upon. CHICS PALACE

tired off a ground-saving journey. PERFECT SUNDAY near the inside in the early stages, was under urging swinging three wide into the stretch, had no offering.
