Footnotes

CHAMOIS just off the pace just off the inside, came under encouragement at the five-sixteenths, spun three wide into the stretch, rallied with good kick collaring the leader a sixteenth out under a drive to prevail. MORE HUNDRED ACRE keen early on stargazing against the rating tactics of the rider, settled tracking from the three path within aim, got asked nearing the quarter pole, inherited the front as COACH A.J. swerved into the temporary rail nearing the final furlong, fought on with good energy getting displaced a sixteenth out, kept on to hold for the place on the wire. NORTH SLOPE hit the off side stall at the start, settled just off the pace three wide, came under a ride at the five-sixteenths, swung four wide in upper stretch, kicked on willingly and just missed the place honors. JAMES JINGLE urged along early inside, shifted to the three path at the five-eighths pole, came under further encouragement midway on the far turn, cornered four wide in upper stretch, offered up a mild kick for the last major share. MR D'ORO saved ground in mid pack ridden along from the five-sixteenths and weakened in the stretch. SAILOR'S REVENGE towards the rear three to four wide, got pushed along at the five-sixteenths, swung three wide in upper stretch offering no serious response and tired. COACH A. J. on the pace inside racing in hand, got let out nearing the quarter pole, cut the corner into the stretch, swerved in crashing through the temporary rail nearing the eighth pole, was put to a protective hold and eased across the finish line. RISK MANAGEMENT ducked in at the start brushing the near side stall, was corrected, saved ground and trailed throughout.
