Footnotes

BARGAINING TABLE settled in the two path in the middle of the field after the start, picked up the pace during the run around the second bend, got taken outward until three wide in upper stretch, closed in rapidly to a poke a head down in front with a furlong remaining, the outmost of a threesome in close proximity to each other at that stage, kicked away under a hand drive. LUCKY NANCY E. bumped with FROM TIZ MOMENT ON leaving the gate went on for a couple of jumps before being brushed by the same one, patiently prompted the pacesetter from the two path, closed in approaching the quarter pole and got set down for the drive home, was in the middle of a trio with an eighth to go, failed to keep pace with the top one thereafter but remained well clear of the others for the place award. BOUNTY PINK initially squeezed at the start, due to pressure originating from VINDICATION SPOT at the start, checked when bumped by a rider-less KEEN ON GREEN shortly afterwards, tucked along the inside route, slipped off it near the half mile pole, gained ground getting asked for run, including some right handed stick work, from near the five-sixteenths marker, flattened out in the final furlong. ALWAYSINMYCIRCLE broke alertly and maintained the advantage, was sent over to the inside, set the splits, being rated on a loosely-contested lead, felt an up tick in the pressure after three-quarters had been run and was soon let out, relinquished a short distance from the eighth pole, then backed away readily. HOPE FOR TOMORROW, had the rider take hold hard on the reins after ducking out as the field was sent on its way, travelled three wide on the opening bend, was closer to the rail on the subsequent one, failed to menace. FROM TIZ MOMENT ON squeezed at the break, was in the middle of the course when forced to idle behind the rider-less rival for a good portion of the way towards the beginning of the first turn, raced in the two path to the top of the lane, made no impact. VINDICATION SPOT came out after bobbling at the start, brushing with the nearest opponent and causing some crowding that affected two additional rivals, tracked the pace from the inside and gave way. KEEN ON GREEN stumbled right after the start, losing the rider in the process. There was a Stewards' inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
