FLASHY BULL raced close up outside, advanced nearing the stretch, responded when roused and drew clear under a drive. CITY ATTRACTION was hustled to the front, set the pace along the inside, was no match for the winner and stayed on to hold the place. RICARDO A was outrun early, rallied three wide into the stretch and was outfinished for the place. DOC CHENEY was outrun early, split rivals on the turn, came wide into the stretch and rallied outside. DYNERGY was outrun early, raced inside and had no rally. INDIAN HAWKE chased the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch. CHAMP SAFI stumbled at the start, raced inside and had no rally. FINAL STORY raced five wide and tired. GOLDEN HARPOON was hustled along outside, chased the pace while four wide and tired. BOLD MON tired after a half mile.
