Footnotes

PROMISE ME A CAT tracked the front inside saving ground while under reserve, swung three to four wide around the pace makers at the head of the lane while engaged by the rider, took command nearing the eighth pole, inched away under a drive kept busy to the end. TWICE THE LADY settled towards the rear saving ground in the two path, came under a ride nearing the head of the lane, cut the corner into the stretch, rallied along the rail safely securing the place while unable to reel in the top one. WILDCAT ALY reserved at the rear, was pushed along from the three-eighths placed in the two path through the turn, shifted out one path near the three-sixteenths, had a clear lane open up shortly thereafter and steadily gained no match for the top pair while able to secure show honors. LADY VI bumped at the start when LINDZ WINZ came out, was unhurried early, raced three wide through the turn coming under coaxing at the three-eighths pole, swung four to five wide in upper stretch offering up a mild kick for the last major share. EDEN STAR pressed the pace while three wide, was set down at the quarter pole and faltered. STOCKINGS set the pace from the two path pressed through the turn, was let out at the head of the lane, stayed on prominent until the final eighth and gave way. LINDZ WINZ broke out at the start bumping LADY VI, chased the pace from the two path, was under a ride at the five-sixteenths and tired.
