### Footnotes

KIBOSH away in good order, patiently sat within range from off the inside, was steadied and placed at least four wide past the three-eighths pole in response to the incident occurring at that juncture, began to close the gap and was called upon entering the stretch, kicked away from others during the ensuing furlong to arrive at the eighth pole with a comfortable advantage and safely maintained it to the end. RIOLAMA was lightly bumped from both sides at the start, proceeded along unhurried from off the rail, swung four wide into the stretch, was straightened away and came home with good energy to secure second. SOUTH SHORE brushed lightly with RIOLAMA at the break, raced along the outside, began to pick up the pace upon departing the backstretch, stayed a prominent factor until midlane then flattened out. STRATEGIC MISSILE contently stalked the pacesetter from the two path for much of the initial half, picked up interest and ranged up to confront SALLY'S DREAM after going a short way down the backstretch, grabbed away the lead and was nearly a body length to the good for a couple of jumps, had the previously mentioned rival creep back up alongside, appeared to come in slightly, brushing with and placing that foe in tight enough to stumble and have its pilot lose both irons, was taken back outward to be more in the two path after all this had happened, felt the pressure increasing prior to heading for the top of the lane and was called upon, relinquished and tired. SHESABRONXBOMBER rode the rail for six furlongs, vacated the premises to steer around a tiring opponent, came up empty. SALLY'S DREAM broke on top, was put to a firm hold and rated while showing the way, had STRATEGIC MISSILE draw abreast and take over about midway down the backstretch, moved up and re bid for command, was alongside the leader when caught in tight quarters a short distance from three-eighths pole, got brushed, then stumbled, with the rider losing his balance and eventually coming out of both irons while tipping out into three path during it all, fell back to midpack with the loss of momentum, had the rider successfully back it both irons spinning into the lane, was set down but lacked a solid response. SHEZA HEARTBREAKER rated unkindly in the earliest stages of a ground-saving journey, faded. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the incident on the far turn before the result was declared official.
