CACTUS CITY ROAD was placed along the inside route near the half mile pole, contended for command with the second place finisher, got set down for the drive home, lengthened away down the lane. TEN ITEMS OR LESS pressed the issue from the two path on the turn, got shaken off, held on well enough to secure second. CAN'T CATCH ME NOW tracked the pace from the inside to the quarter pole, arrived at that station under some hand urging, got put to much stronger handling angling about three wide into the stretch, started to come out past the three-sixteenths marker, resisted the rider's attempt to get put back on a straighter course, wound up carrying out a hapless VELVET CAP as well as making some contact with that opponent, the most significant occurring at the furlong marker, settled into his best stride shortly afterwards and rallied for the show. PATRIOTIC DUTY gave chase from the two path, got maneuvered to the four path, nudging EVERYDOGHASHISDAY in the process at three-eighths pole, to allow a pilot-less MARKER BLASTER access to the outside at that juncture, was back near the two path spinning into the lane, under encouragement, had no rally. VELVET CAP chased the front runners from the three path around the bend, having been put to a drive by the midway point on the turn, found himself trapped between rivals coming to midlane, the one to the outside being without a jockey, got bumped from between them before bobbling and getting hold of after making additional contact with CAN'T CATCH ME NOW in the vicinity of the eighth pole, weakened steadily thereafter. EVERYDOGHASHISDAY departed the backstretch from the three path, got pushed onto the overland route by the rider of PATRIOTIC DUTY who was safely eluding the rider-less rival midpoint on the turn, had no offering. MARKET BLASTER stumbled badly at the start, unseating the rider. There was a Stewards' Inquiry focusing on the start of the race before the result was declared official.
