Footnotes

MS. SYLVIA A. broke to the outside, was taken hold by the pilot and pulled away from the nearest opponent before contact between them, got guided into the pocket coming to the half mile pole, patiently kept watch on the pair up ahead, proceeded to get angled out near the five-sixteenths marker, was the widest of three front runners spinning into the stretch, gained command soon afterwards and drew off, crossing the wire being hand urged. ISLAND CANDY away without apparent mishap, was rankly pulling on the bit during the initial portion of the run along the backstretch, seemingly intent on getting out, went about more professionally pressing the pace from the two path during the run around the bend, challenged earnestly for command from between opponents spinning into the stretch, couldn't keep up with the winner, held on well though for the place award. BROWN MELLISA gave chase primarily from the two path on the bend, fanned four to five wide, the widest of all, into upper stretch, proved no match. FAST 'N' FIRM was carried out slightly by the top one at the start, raced from off the inside, was in the two path getting roused by midway on the turn, failed to respond. PRINCES ON THELAKE bobbled leaving the starting gate, yet still broke in front, established command, was put to test by a pair of opponents parked to the outside in paths two and three coming to the quarter pole, got set down prior to reaching that station, readily relinquished, began to shorten stride noticeably coming to the sixteenth pole and was eased late.
