REPTILIAN SMARTS was unhurried while saving ground, waited inside on the turn, swung four wide splitting horses to get clear at the quarter pole and unleashed a strong late run under right hand urging in the middle of the track to win going away. DON MISIL (ARG) stumbled at the start, pressed a moderate pace in the two path into upper stretch, made a run to challenge inside the furlong marker and held well for the place. BOBBY SANDS raced in good position along the rail, made a run to reach contention in upper stretch and was outfinished late. FANCY RUNNER was outrun along the inside into upper stretch and rallied mildly. HELSINKI raced in midpack between horses while three wide and lacked a late response. GREENSPIRIT was under a firm hold while setting a moderate pace along the rail, led into midstretch and gave way. SARATOGA LULABY checked after being bumped at the start, raced up close while four wide, gave way on the turn and was eased late.
