TRUTH WILL TELL underwent a three wide pursuit, steadily advanced towards the pacesetter during the run around the bend, was let out a notch at the midway point and under a full drive a sixteenth down the road, spun into the lane, latched on to GLORIETTA BAY, took away the lead during the ensuing furlong and edged clear, kept to a drive. VICTORY FOR V L TS gave chase from the outside under encouragement all the while, finished well belatedly to garner the place. GLORIETTA BAY argued for control from the inside, was put to a stern test approaching the quarter pole and soon succumbed. CHEROKEE TRICK went head to head with GLORIETTA BAY making her way down the chute, with the pilot of both sitting atop with a firm grip on the reins, was taken back and tucked along the rail early down the backstretch, tracked the front runners riding the rail until upper stretch, tipped into the three path but lacked the necessary stretch response. FASHION'S FLIGHT off the inside, trailed.
