### Footnotes

WORTH A BUCK raced three wide, was put to a prolonged drive, gained steadily on the front runners from upper to midstretch, poked a head in front at the eighth pole, the outermost of three at that station and drew clear while kept busy. CUSTER broke on top and quickly established command, was near the inside for most of the run down the chute prior to tucking over to the rail at the five-eighths pole, a bit too close for comfort for the rider of MAGICAL MYTH, who checked hard at that station, showed the way with DIAMOND DISTRICT paying full attention and applying good pressure, fought with rival as well as the eventual winner for much of the run through the furlong grounds before relinquishing at the eighth pole, dug in stubbornly to preserve the place. DIAMOND DISTRICT disputed the pace from the outside, got out finished. BRIDGE TO NOWHERE three wide departing the backstretch, rallied mildly to improve position. COPPER FOREST raced along the outside and lacked the necessary stretch response. MAGICAL MYTH tucked along the rail shortly after entering the backstretch, checked hard off the runner up's heels coming to the five-eighths pole, recovered and continued to track that opponent taking the inside route, faltered. SECRET GETAWAY in the four path at the half mile pole, had no kick. PISTOLS AT DAWN three wide and asked at the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. MACHO MUCHACHO saved ground throughout. METROLOGY three wide on the turn, folded.
