### Footnotes

SHANGHAI BOBBY made light contact with DO YOU SMELL SMOKE just out of the starting gate, seemed unperturbed and went about his business securing a forward post, chased the pacesetter from off the rail, was taken hold, pausing as it were before being guided into the four path coming to the five-sixteenths pole, picked up speed readily after completing this maneuver and went after the front runners in earnest, reached the eighth pole having drawn abreast of the second place finisher, was a full body length to the good a sixteenth down the road and drew off, crossing the wire under a vigorous hand ride. JU JU EYEBALLS broke sharply and took up residence in the two path, vied for command around the bend with DO YOU SMELL SMOKE directly to his outside, had the winner join the fracas by upper stretch, yielded when unable to keep pace, this occurring a short distance past the furlong marker, continued on willingly to earn the place. DO YOU SMELL SMOKE came in slightly after losing his footing as the field was sent off and running, making light contact shoulder to shoulder with the top one, went on to contest the pace three wide on the turn, tired after entering the stretch. THE PARTY'S HERE hard used right from the get-go, got out hustled, was taken in hand and given a respite from midpoint until the five-sixteenths pole, was hard used for a second time, departing that station, angled outward at the eighth pole still having no headway on the front runners and gave way. MAJESTIC WIND came in a bit at the start, felt the whip repeatedly on the right shoulder proceeding towards the turn, swung four wide into upper stretch, had no rally. CABS ARE HERE off the inside, trailed.
