GET RIGHT away in good order, quickly established control and was guided over to the rail, rated kindly cutting the pace, with GODOFGOODFORTUNE in close attendance in the two path, continued along on the same scenario for nearly five furlongs, shook free momentarily coming to the quarter pole and was let out, drifted towards the middle of the course during the initial portion of the stretch drive, arrived at the eighth pole with the runner up alongside, commencing a spirited tussle between those two for the rest of the way, rubbed shoulders twice with that rival while battling for command from midstretch until deep stretch, was trailing by a neck when bumped soundly by BIG JOHN B just prior to the wire after that foe came in slightly, went on to regain the lead after the incident in time to prevail. BIG JOHN B sat reserved in midpack from off the inside, was guided three wide coming to the three-eighths pole and unleashed a sweeping move from that station to reach contention, achieving this without being asked for run, spun into the stretch and only then was called upon, reached the eighth pole on nearly even terms with GET RIGHT, grabbed a slim advantage, rubbing shoulders with his fellow combatant in the heat of the battle two times, came inward a bit a few strides before reaching the finish line, initiating solid contact with the top one and getting turned sideways, and lost the lead as a result. MR E PHILIP stalked the pacesetter from the outside, was set down in upper stretch and proved no match for the

top pair. LURE OF THE SOUTH saved ground and lacked the necessary stretch response. MR. BEER GOGGLES tracked inside, hesitated coming to the five-sixteenths pole before going by a weakening GODOFGOODFORTUNE, then faltered. SUPER SATURDAY raced along the outside and had no rally. DUNCANS CIRCLE three wide on the far turn, was no threat. COCODIMAMA between rivals on the second turn, came up empty for the stretch run. GODOFGOODFORTUNE accompanied the leader from the two path for just over a half, tired badly and was eased in midstretch. GO FOR TWO well off the inside throughout, fought continuously against the rider for the opening three-quarters, was put to a protective hold drifting very wide into the stretch and got eased.
