Footnotes

SUPERIORITY departed the backstretch three wide, began to pick up the pace during the later stages of the run around the bend, moved past a tiring FIRSTBELLATHENKK a short distance from the quarter pole and challenged earnestly at that station, made minimal progress during the initial portion of the stretch run, came inward one path after some right handed stick work, clogging up a narrow passageway of possible use by the runner up a short distance behind at the stage, had the rider switch the stick to the opposite side, grabbed a slim lead in deep stretch then reached the wire in time to fend off the second place finisher. TYCOON CAT off slowly, was put to strong motivation by the rider right from the get-go getting propelled into a striking distance, raced towards the inside, showed an indication of wanting to swing outward coming to the quarter pole, but lacked an opportunity with FIRSTBELLATHENKK racing alongside at that moment, tipped outward to be two wide at the top of the lane, was approaching a seam between the front runners at the furlong marker when the winner came in slightly but enough to shut it down, altered course sharply to the outside, undergoing the maneuver with little room to spare from the top one's heels, drifted out several paths while rallying, just fell short. A. F. HENNESSEY vied to maintain command from the inside, held on well before yielding late. PATRIOTIC DUTY swung four wide into upper stretch and was outrun. FIRSTBELLATHENKK chased the pacesetter from the outside for under a half and gave way. An objection lodged by the rider of TYCOON CAT against the rider of SUPERIORITY alleging interference in the stretch was not allowed.
