COOLUSIVE raced along the outside, was put to a drive in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths marker and swung about three wide into the stretch, caught the errant second place finisher near the finish line to prevail. MUCH STRONGER under a firm hold by the pilot at the time, moved past ALL JONESY to take charge shortly after the start, began to drift outward after going halfway around the bend, was three wide by the head of the stretch, continued on a course towards the grandstand apron and got caught prior to the wire. S'MAVERLOUS was guided over to the rail midway down the backstretch, lacked the needed response off the subsequent ground-saving journey. ALL JONESY bobbed at the start, yet was still the first to pop out of the starting gate, had the advantage taken away by the runner up, chased that opponent in a tepid manner from off the inside, fell back slightly despite getting asked for run at the five-sixteenths pole and gave way. GOLDEN GREELEY raced along the outside and was outrun.
