Footnotes

CHERYLWITHANS assumed a forward position after the start, disputed the pace as the widest of three until a short distance past the half mile pole, continued the fight one on one with the runner up thereafter, was under a drive before the start of the stretch run, arrived at the eighth pole after a spirited tussle with WINDS OF CHANGE still clinging to a narrow advantage, raced erratically during the next sixteenth weaving back and forth several paths at a time, shook free for good at the sixteenth pole and drew away late. WINDS OF CHANGE vied for the lead from between rivals until the seven-sixteenths pole, dueled with the winner the rest of the way around the bend once PRINCES ON THELAKE dropped back slightly, got set down to a drive as the initial half was dwindling down, stayed in contention until about a sixteenth to go. BRIANNA NICOLE placed three wide at the head of the stretch, went on to finish a non-threatening third. BAAL PERAZIM under encouragement coming four wide into the lane, made no headway. PRINCES ON THELAKE along the inside, argued for command with another pair for slightly more than a quarter, faltered after entering the stretch. EVA LIL put to hand urging after an uneventful getaway from the starting gate, was slow to settle into stride. KAY SPITFIRE SANDY saved ground while getting asked for run on the turn, faded.
