MY GOLDEN GIRL chased the pacesetter from the outside, got put to a drive approaching the five-sixteenths pole, rapidly cut into the gap, with BRICKHOUSE BABY in tow one path to the outside, entered the stretch and commenced a duel with the second place finisher, was initially carried out by that opponent, with both rivals leaning heavily upon each other at intervals, was in possession of the barest of leads with an eighth to go, got switched over to a left handed stick by the pilot and drifted outward several paths on his own initiative during much of the final sixteenth, held sway. BINSKY'S GOLD was sent over to the inside after the start, showed the way from there, under the attention of another pair, parked out in paths two and three, had them range up in unison late on the turn and was asked for run prior to arriving at the quarter pole, drifted out, nudging the top one to do so as well, got displaced on the front, fought onward but failed to reclaim the advantage. BRICKHOUSE BABY underwent a three wide pursuit, was given her cue and crept up towards the pacesetter, challenged briefly as the trio of frontrunners spun into the lane then flattened out. GALAXY GAL made light contact with MY LUCKY LIEU at the start, rode the rail, was asked for a response leaving the three-eighths pole, cut the corner under much stronger handling and under the whip, faltered. MY LUCKY LIEU brushed with GALAXY GAL at the break, drifted very wide proceeding down the chute, was guided inward and eventually placed along the inside route midway down the backstretch, failed to reach a contending position.
