Footnotes

STAR OF NEW YORK well off the inside throughout, briefly drafted behind SUPERIORITY during the early stages of the run around the bend, tipped wider and crept up menacingly from the four path starting from the five-sixteenths marker, maintained the momentum and drove his way to the lead, drew off. MEEKER AVENUE along the inside, got put to the test by a pair parked to the outside approaching the three-eighths pole, turned them back, but proved no match for the winner. SUPERIORITY sat patiently perched in the three path, challenged as the widest of three for command midway on the turn, kept up the pursuit in earnest for about a furlong, then got outfinished by the top twosome. TINY PREDICAMENT departed the backstretch being two wide, got put to strong encouragement after slightly more than halfway around the bend, fanned outward until about five wide by the three-sixteenths marker, tired in the final furlong. STRAIGHT FAX saved ground and made no impact. FESTIVE SPIRIT pressed the issue from the two path, kept it up but from between opponents as the half was being completed, tired steadily after turning for home. DENN PIPER chased the front runners from the two path on the turn, was never in the hunt. GREELEY'S LAW three wide at the three-eighths pole, displayed brief foot.
