WHAT'S YOUR POINT raced close up along the inside, came wide into the stretch and lacked a rally. CATELEISHA was bumped on the backstretch, raced three wide and had no rally. KATHLEEN'S CHANCE raced inside and tired. LIGHT CLASSIC was bumped on the backstretch, raced wide throughout and tired.
