SHORT FUSE TARA stalked the pacesetter from the outside, moved willingly while three wide on turn, continued to gain readily once in the lane, collared the leader just pace the furlong marker and drew off under good handling. LADY JOVE quickly on the lead, set a strong pace while racing along the rail, proved no match for the winner during the final furlong but continued on with good energy to secure the place. BABY GRAY rated in midpack, gradually gained ground on the turn once set down, had his rider lose his whip in upper stretch, loomed briefly midstretch but could advance no further. EXPIRATION DAY was outrun early, launched a four wide bid on the turn, failed to sustain that move, tiring late. ZEYARAAT chased the pace along the inside for a half and tired. SKIPPER TALE raced wide throughout and lacked a rally. HAND ME DOWN stumbled at the start, saved ground thereafter while never posing a threat. BALLYMIST in early contention from the outside a half, tired badly.
