MY SNOOKIE'S PAL out broke the field, but was soon dragged back, with the rider applying a firm grip on the reins, stayed within range of the pace battle down the backstretch, began the run around the second bend from the three path, closed in with good speed when asked for some run from the five-sixteenths pole, struck the front at the quarter pole, the outermost of a tightly-bunched threesome, lengthened away from there to the eighth pole and maintained a safe winning margin being hand urged to the wire. RED TO POSITIVE sat reserved in the back of the pack while taking the inside route, began to swing outward leaving the five-sixteenths pole, hesitated for a stride or two before completing the maneuver into the four path at the top of the stretch, rallied willingly once straightened away to grab the place. WISE CHOICE was placed along the inside soon after the start, made a middle move down the backstretch to reach a good striking position, was forced to steady off a rival's heels when caught in traffic a short distance from the quarter pole, managed to squeeze into the two path right near the quarter pole, was called upon but proved no match for the top twosome. WACHIWI dueled along the rail and weakened during the final furlong. SWEETHEARTS KISS argued the pace from the outside for six furlongs and gave way. IRISH MISS three wide around the turn, tired.
