I'VE GOT SPEED spun three wide into the backstretch, was kept under a snug hold for nearly three-quarters, unleashed a bold five wide move in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole, powered by rivals to stretch out to a lengthy lead with an eighth to go and went on to cross the finish line with authority, a handy winner. J J'S PROPHET coaxed tracking the front runner from the pocket, angled off the inside for the stretch run, but proved no match for the top one. CAN'T REFUSE saved ground, was guided off the rail gearing up for the stretch drive, commenced to rally in earnest five wide at the head of the stretch and was along for the show. HURRICANE HEAT a forward factor along the outside for six furlongs, made no serious bids throughout the running. OIL MAN (IRE) underwent a three to four wide journey and folded. NEW YORK STYLE rated in the two path until the five-sixteenths pole while showing the way, gave out. BUDGET pressed three wide for nearly three-quarters and came to a halt coming into the lane.
