WILDCAT'S SMILE broke inward, making contact with SING DIXIE SING before being pulled off that opponent, advanced into contention from the three path under some hand urging upon entering the turn, vied for command as the outermost member of a threesome from the five-sixteenths pole until midstretch, grabbed the lead for good at that point and edged away, driving. EASY ENDING took up a forward position right from the start, contently stalked the leader from the outside for nearly a half, picked up the pace from midpoint on the turn, had the winner arrive on the scene late on the bend, fought from between rivals from there until the furlong marker, held on well to end to garner the place. SING DIXIE SING was bumped by the top one at the start, went on to grab the lead and tucked along the inside, cut the initial splits facing only mild resistance, came under pressure from a pair of rivals approaching the five-sixteenths pole and was soon asked for some run, resisted each of them before yielding just prior to the eighth pole, eventually weakening into the show slot. DECORATED COURT swung four wide into upper stretch, proved no match for the first three finishers. ALPHABET JAMERICA tracked inside and faltered. JACKIE MO fidgety in the starting gate, tossing her head back and forth, was steadied after making a sharp left turn, beginning a good four to five lengths behind the next to last runner before settling into stride, rode the rail until the quarter pole and was outrun.
