DADDY'S WILDCAT broke well, set a solid pace from the two path under very light coaxing, awaited a challenge at the head of the lane, was fully engaged by the rider coming to the final furlong, held well to the wire under a drive safely in front. JADE GLORY AGAIN pursued the front from close range while three wide in the turn and under reserve, was let out at the quarter pole, steadily cut into the margin of the leader through the lane unable to reel him in while widening away a clear second best. GREYFRIARS opted to not vie for the lead and was eased off the speedy leader near the seven-sixteenths, tracked the front from the two path around the turn, was shaken up in earnest at the head of the lane, couldn't match strides with the top pair through the furlong grounds while weakening and well clear for show honors. HARRY CONSOLIDATOR isolated in midpack through the turn well off the front while safely ahead of the back flight, saved ground throughout, stayed on through the lane to garner the last major share best of the rest. SOLID D'ORO outrun early on , saved ground racing from the two path through the turn, rallied by tired rivals in the lane while never a menace. COBALT RED broke in at the start bumping lightly with POP'S DOLLY, chased the front from afar thereafter and never threatened. STANLEY KOWALSKY raced three wide while outrun early and was no factor. POP'S DOLLY bumped at the start when COBALT RED broke in, trailed throughout.
