Footnotes

MAGICAL CAT (IRE) broke in at the start and was corrected before any contact could be made, saved ground in midpack, came under urging at the five-sixteenths, swung out to be four wide in upper stretch for a clear lane, rallied with a good kick down the center of the course to prevail edging away late. SINGN ON THEMOON unhurried three wide the closest pursuer to the loose leader, was set down at the quarter pole, was bumped solidly coming to the final eighth by the weakening leader drifting out, gained the slimmest of margins with a furlong to go, ran on with a good kick unable to answer the aforementioned rival's kick while securing the place. ZULTANITE midpack well placed while under reserve, saved ground throughout from the two path, was let out at the head of the lane, shifted in one path nearing the final furlong as the weakening leader drifted out, rallied down along the inside to garner the show. SYLVESTRIS (IRE) unsettled early on resisting the hold by the rider, tracked inside more professionally after straightening down the backside, was pushed along from the five-sixteenths, cut the corner into the lane into prominence, couldn't match kicks with the top threesome in the late stages being out kicked while retaining the last major share. STRATEGIC MISSILE set the pace lightly coaxed just off the inside unprompted and loose, was set down at the top of the stretch as the field closed in, drifted in near the three-sixteenths in reaction to the rider's encouragement right handed, drifted out when corrected shortly thereafter bumping SINGN ON THEMOON soundly just prior to the eighth pole, remained in contention until the final sixteenth and weakened in the late stages. FREEDOM RINGS towards the rear under reserve, was pushed along from the midway point on the far turn and made no headway through the stretch. CENTRINA eased back after the start, saved ground throughout while trailing.
