M P JOE departed the backstretch three wide, marched into contention, got tipped into the four path in the vicinity of the five-sixteenths pole and after going another couple of jumps was asked for a response, gave it readily, arriving at the furlong marker just shy of the lead, gained it soon afterwards, then edged away, driving. ASSET INFLATION worked out a tuck into the pocket coming to the end of the backstretch, didn't stay in it for too long, was put to some encouragement and asked to pick up speed, did so, and after clearing a tiring CLOSINGTOWIRE angled into the two path, ranged up on the leader and challenged in earnest as the pair turned for home, forged his way to a slim advantage but had no sooner done so when put to an assault by the eventual winner, relinquished to that one's persistent onslaught past the eighth pole but continued onward willingly to secure second. STONE ROCKS darted over to the rail, rode it for nearly a half, was put to encouragement and scurried into contention during the run around the bend, angled outward entering the stretch, flattened out. D J'S HOPE cut the pace from the inside, came under heavy pressure from the second place finisher heading for the quarter pole, yielded before making it through the furlong grounds and tired. MAGIC Q. G. underwent a three wide pursuit, was under a drive by the five-sixteenths marker, folded. CAN'T CATCH ME NOW raced along the outside, hesitated before splitting foes late on the turn, had no rally. BUSTIN CHOPS loped along in the initial stages, cut the corner into the lane, failed to menace. CLOSINGTOWIRE chased the leader from the two path, was through before completing a half.
