Footnotes

HAY SHARES grabbed a narrow advantage after the start, was guided over towards the rail but was kept at a slight distance from off it while vying to maintain command, reached the quarter pole, with the closest pursuers all within striking distance and having been asked for run, got asked for some himself, remained in the clear under a drive. LEILANI'S TICKET pressed the winner from the two path, coaxed along to maintain interest, spun into the lane under much stronger handling, made up some ground in the late stages but had to settle for the place. STONELY THE LONELY chased the front runners from along the outside, was taken over to the rail leaving the furlong grounds, lacked a solid closing punch. OVEREXTENDED rode the rail for nearly a half, was swung outward late on the turn and eventually placed three wide at the head of the stretch, then was allowed to drift wider still, mustered up a mild kick to take the final major slice of the pot. REGGIE D three to four wide on the turn, the widest of all, had no rally. FLO'S GREATNESS chased three wide and tired. CUVEE CITY forwardly placed after leaving the starting gate, was put to a firm grip on the reins by the pilot and taken back coming to the half mile pole, tracked the pacesetter while continuing to save ground on the bend, got set down for the stretch, faltered.
