STARRY DE hit the gate at the start, stumbled, was bumped after the start, raced with the pace while three wide, dug in gamely when roused and prevailed after a long drive. READY raced with the pace while between rivals and dug in gamely while between rivals in the stretch. GETADDERIT was outrun early, came wide into the stretch and finished gamely outside. MIDNITE DEELITE was bumped at the start, was ran under restraint early, rallied inside and finished well while in traffic in the stretch. HERZBLATT was rated along early, advanced inside on the second turn and finished well on the rail. PIANO CHIMES raced three wide throughout and had no rally. BRANDALA was rated along inside, came wide for the drive and lacked a rally. ENTER set the pace along the inside and tired in the final furlong. HALLEY'S FIELD raced inside and tired.
