DELTA SENSATION was outrun early, raced inside, responded when roused and was along in time. DREAMADREAMFORME was unhurried early, angled out in upper stretch and finished gamely outside. PACIFIC ISLAND pressed the pace from the outside, drew clear in the stretch and tired in the final furlong. GRAND PRAYER raced close up outside, rallied three wide approaching the stretch and tired in the drive. MUSETTA'S WALTZ set the pace along the inside and tired in the stretch.
