KIPPERS N' EGGS made a three wide run to the lead into the first turn, set the pace from just off the inside in the two path on hold and accompanied to his outside, marshaled the field around the far turn and was let out at the head of the lane, quickened to a clear advantage with an eighth to go, continued under a drive to the end while well clear. KITTEN IN MAY was off a beat slow and taken in hand at the start when HEADINGTOTHECITY veered in, settled at the rear off the inside, was coaxed along at the three-eighths while three wide in the turn, swung four wide in upper stretch, kicked home with good energy down the center of the course to procure the place in the last jump while never a threat to the winner. MONASTIR reserved off the pace, made steady progress on the front while three wide through the turn, swung four wide at the head of the lane and was called upon, displayed a good kick through the furlong grounds, drifted in sharply at the finish from left handed stick work just missing the place while garnering the show honors.

HEADINGTOTHECITY veered in at the start bumping TOCSET'S IMAGE and forcing KITTEN IN MAY to be taken briefly in hand, was forwardly placed tracking the front well rated until the three-eighths, made a three wide bid through the turn towards the front, ran on through the lane evenly being outfinished in the late stages nearing the wire while in a bit tight between rivals. PARKINSON FIELD tracked the pace inside well rated and covered up, was let out at the top of the lane, ran on well through the stretch being out kicked in the late stages. STORMY SUCCESS saved ground throughout towards the rear, was set down at the top of the lane and rallied mildly by tired rivals. TOCSET'S IMAGE bumped at the start by HEADINGTOTHECITY who veered in, sat in midpack in the two path, came under urging midway on the turn and offered no kick. MUTINY accompanied the pace setter while two to three wide, was asked for run at the top of the stretch and tired. WILDLEE SPECIAL saved ground towards the rear and was no factor. HARDSHELL tracked inside while prominent for a half and faded.
