Footnotes

MISSILE MOTOR three wide in close pursuit of a solid pace, moved in tandem to confront the leader with METAURUS coming to the head of the stretch, displaced the front with his main rival taking command at the quarter pole, was set down matching strides through the lane on even terms with a sixteenth to go, dug in gamely to prevail in the final few strides in a determined effort. METAURUS prompted the pacemaker initially inside that rival until approaching the turn, opted to slip out to the two path as the leader steadily made his way to the rail, moved as a team with MISSILE MOTOR to confront the speedy pacesetter approaching the quarter pole, took command at that station under a drive, held the slimmest of leads with a furlong to go, battled on through the lane stubbornly, yielded grudgingly in the final strides well clear for place honors in a solid effort. MAX'S FIRST bumped lightly at the start with CALGARY ENFORCER, was reserved of the pace, swung five wide in upper stretch under a drive, was herded out through in the initial portion of the stretch from his inside rival KEECHI BULLET who was drifting from left handed encouragement, kicked on mildly to garner the show honors in the last jump. KEECHI BULLET pushed along from the three-eighths in midpack, was four wide in upper stretch, drifted out under left handed encouragement through the early portions of the stretch drive herding out MAX'S FIRST two paths while offering a mild bid for the last major share. HOPEFUL BOY hustled to the front, set a solid prompted pace from just off the inside, was confronted nearing the head of the stretch, got displaced on the front at that juncture, remained prominent until the eighth pole and faded. RAYNICK'S JET rear early on, took the two path through the turn, swung three wide in upper stretch and offered little. LIBERTY ST. OUTLAW off a beat slow, was squeezed after the start from pressure from the outside and taken in hand, shifted to the rail coming under hustling to be forwardly placed, paused briefly off heels entering the turn, continued the prolonged drive throughout and tired. TOKEN SACRIFICE outrun in

the early going, came under a long drive from the three-eighths pole and was no factor. CALGARY ENFORCER bumped lightly at the start with MAX'S FIRST and trailed throughout.
