ABILIO quickly established control, cut the pace, well rated from the inside, with the runner up in close attendance from the two path and also being rated, continued along on the same scenario until the quarter pole, got asked for a response at that station and fended off CARSON HALL to preserve the decision. CARSON HALL chased the winner from the outside, lacked the kick needed to reel that rival in. ETERNAL RULER (IRE) swung four wide into the stretch and rallied for the show. KING CONGIE underwent a ground-saving journey and was vanned off after crossing the wire. SCREENPLAY three wide and asked at the five-sixteenths pole, came up empty. KENTUCKY REIGN saved ground and failed to menace. MYTHICAL HERO fanned from the five path into upper stretch, had no offering to render.
