Footnotes

ALTERNATIVE MEDS loping along with the rest of the front runners during the initial stages, got checked after nearly running up BELLE OF THE WEST, settled down and took up residence in the three path, patiently stalked the leader being just as wide on the far turn until the five-sixteenths pole, picked up interest and challenged in earnest as the widest of a trio on nearly even terms with each other, won the tussle through the furlong grounds to gain a slim lead by the eighth pole, dug in stubbornly the rest of the way to preserve it. LET THE KITTEN RUN three wide on the far turn, was given her cue and commenced to launch a rally a short distance prior to the quarter pole, closed in steadily on the front runners from upper to midstretch, tried hard but couldn't overhaul the winner. GO OLIVIA GO saved ground for six furlongs, was on the move outward until eventually placed four wide at the head of the stretch, was straightened away and came home with good energy to take the show. BELLE OF THE WEST quickly tucked along the inside, contently remained in the pocket for over three-quarters, was put to encouragement and angled outward into the stretch, lacked the needed response. CAUTION SIGN was grabbed hold after getting squeezed back at the start, rushed past a group of firmly-gripped rivals to zip into command well before reaching the end of the homestretch, was guided over to the inside, set the opening splits, well rated and facing no resistance, began to feel some upon departing the backstretch, came under heavier pressure by the end of the second bend, getting put to the test by a pair of rivals, with several others, now being roused in close proximity behind, vied with a pair from the quarter pole to the furlong marker, yielded and steadily weakened. IM A ROCKSTAR DIVA swung off the rail entering the backstretch, was unhurried down the backstretch and for most of the way on the far turn as well, got taken inward shortly after making it into the stretch, launched an abbreviated rail run then flattened out. SILENT JOY stalked the leader from the outside without making her presence felt the initial half, began to range up after stepping foot on the second bend, drew alongside CAUTION SIGN and challenged for command from between opponents from the quarter pole to midlane, gave way. HONEY DUE TELL three wide until the three-eighths pole, trailed.
